LESSON 1: RESEARCH ON POLAR BEAR BEHAVIOURS

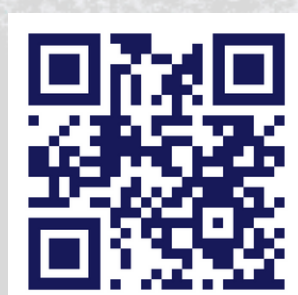
In groups, students will research and compile information about the three types of polar bear behaviors: predatory, defensive, and non-threatening. Students will outline safety actions recommended for each behavior type, as communicated in the Bear Safety Animation video.

LESSON 2: INFORMATIONAL BOOK CREATION

Using gathered information, students will collaborate to create an informational book on polar bear behaviors and appropriate safety responses. Include illustrations, facts, and safety tips for each behavior type.

LESSON 3: BEAR BANGERS EXPLORATIONS

Facilitate a discussion on bear bangers as a safety measure against polar bear encounters. Explain their purpose and usage. Research together where bear bangers can be purchased locally or online and their approximate costs. Discuss the importance of being informed about safety tools when exploring polar bear habitats.
